How to use this topic pack

This is an independent preparation collection for the active predicted question-bank cycle. It is not an official IELTS paper, no question is guaranteed, and the questions in your test can be different. Use the range to practise transferable skills rather than memorising complete answers.

Suggested routine

- Part 1: answer directly, then add one reason or personal detail.
- Part 2: plan for one minute using keywords, then speak for one to two minutes.
- Part 3: state a position, explain it and support it with an example or comparison.
- Record before reading a model answer; review one criterion at a time.

Official format reminder

The official Speaking test lasts 11-14 minutes. Part 1 takes 4-5 minutes, Part 2 takes 3-4 minutes including one minute of preparation, and Part 3 takes 4-5 minutes. Academic and General Training candidates take the same Speaking test.
